Turn right out of the guest house. Cross the a66 to the pheasant. Turn right before the pheasant, heading up the hill for ½ mile. Just past rigg farm, there is a gate on the left, taking you onto sale fell. Follow the tracks either left or right to get to the top. You can't get lost and the view of bassenthwaite lake is amazing!


