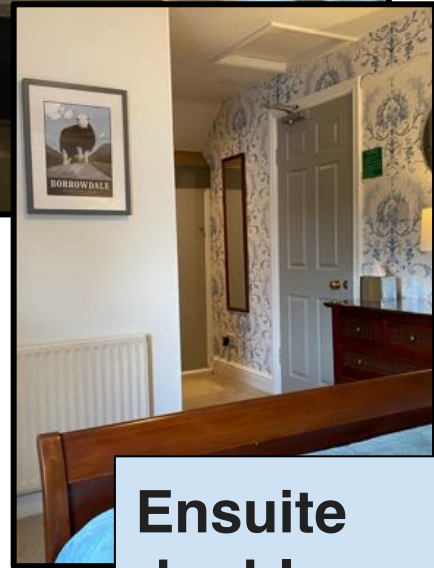

Turn right out of the guest house. Cross the a66 to the pheasant. Turn right before the pheasant, heading up the hill for ½ mile. Just past riggs farm there is a gate on the left, taking you onto sale fell. Follow the tracks either left or right to get to the top. You can't get lost and the view of bassenthwaite lake is amazing!

Go through the gate on your right. Follow the path left round the meadow.

Reed warblers, sedge warblers, reed buntings, chiffchaffs, linnets and nuthatches to name but a few.

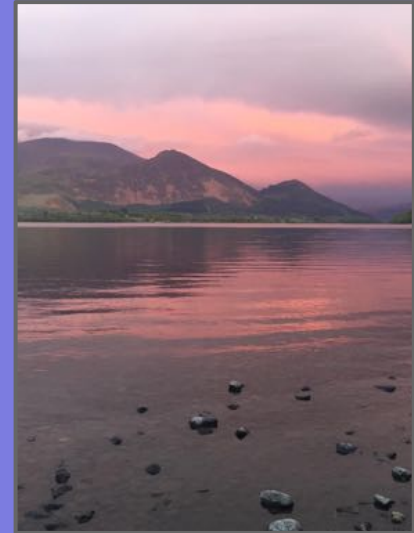
Be aware

To get to the lake, turn left out of the guest house, walking carefully along the road, past the sailing club. Just after the club, there are several gaps in the hedge to get to the path along the lake shore. it is quite rough underfoot but follow the path all the way to ouse bridge where the river derwent leaves the lake.

Cat Bells

Turn right off the A66 at Portinscale, just before Keswick. Follow the road for about 6 miles.

Scafell Pike

Head into Keswick and pick up the signs for Borrowdale. Go all the way down the valley to Seathwaite.

Skiddaw

Head to Latrigg car park at the end of Bassenthwaite Lake, Keswick end.
